➤ DESMOND DAY—TYPE 2 DIABETIC WORKSHOP 8TH FEB 12-4PM

There are currently more than 3 million people in the UK with Type 2 Diabetes. As diabetes is such a common condition I thought it would be useful to ask a specialist nurse to talk to us about diabetes Type 2 and how to manage the condition.

Please join me Jan Zriel Parish Nurse, for DESMOND Type 2 Diabetes education on Friday February 8th from 12 till 4pm facilitated by Cilla Kirkman RGN. Cilla was a diabetic specialist nurse for 23 years and ran DESMOND days as part of her role. Since leaving that post 3 years ago she now runs DESMOND days in the Swindon area for GP practices. Please bring your lunch. Tea and Coffee will be provided. Also make sure you bring your latest HBA1c result (diabetic blood test), cholesterol result and most recent blood pressure recording. Cilla will talk about diagnosis and management and there will be a chance to discuss your diagnosis and concerns as a group and share your stories.
